Brimbank is home to national parks, festivals and cultural events, an expanding food and coffee culture, and fantastic public and street art.

Kick off the new year with the St Albans Lunar Festival in January, the Keilor Gift in February, Sunshine Food Fever and Scrumptious St Albans in March, and the Sunshine Short Film Festival and Sunshine Lantern Festival in September - just to name a few!

Add in the rich history and heritage to be explored, theatre at the Bowery, and fantastic walking and cycling trails - you'll be spoilt for choice every day in Brimbank!

EXPLORE OUR TOWN CENTRES:

DEER PARK

Deer Park has a rich array of restaurants and shopping, but there's a rich history to be discovered at the Hunt Club Community and Arts Centre and Black Powder Mill.
Visitor Tip: Take the kids to see the volcano at Isabella Williams Memorial Reserve!

KEILOR

Keilor has an incredible nature-based offering with the Maribyrnong River, Organ Pipes National Park, Brimbank Park and Green Gully Reserve just waiting to be explored.
Visitor Tip: Experience a bit of country in the city at Keilor Village before taking a tour at the historic Overnewton Castle.

ST ALBANS

Head to St Albans for a 'tour of the world' with great Asian, European and Middle Eastern fare in the shopping strip and the market. Alice's Playspace is a great spot to take a break and let the kids run around to!

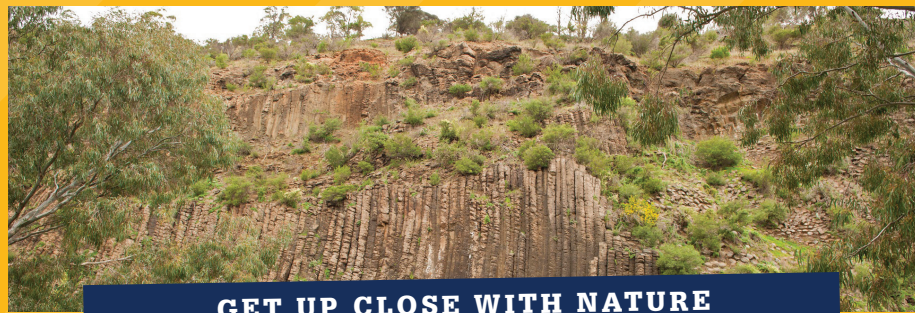
Visitor Tip: Book yourself a seat at the Bowery Theatre for a theatre or music production.

SUNSHINE

Sunshine is not only home to the best of Vietnamese, Afghan, African and Indian cuisine; it's also rich in history just waiting to be explored.
Visitor Tip: Keep a watch out for the array of public art and street art all around Sunshine.

SYDENHAM

When you're looking for a shopping fix, head to Watergardens Town Centre and Station 'Street' which offers visitors a great choice of food. The outdoor area provides a safe spot for the kids to run around while mum and dad relax.
Visitor Tip: A walk or cycle down the Taylors Creek Trail is a must to see the huge red river gums and diverse birdlife on the water.



GET UP CLOSE WITH NATURE

BRIMBANK PARK

Brimbank Park, adjoining the Maribyrnong River in Keilor is a great place to fish, canoe, walk, run and cycle. The park has sheltered picnic areas, gas barbecues, picnic tables, playgrounds and a café.

ORGAN PIPES

The Organ Pipes National Park is home to extraordinary basalt columns formed by the cooling and cracking of molten lava and are the most well-known feature of the park. Spend some time bush walking, enjoy a picnic and take time for a photo opportunity in front of the Organ Pipes - you might even glimpse a wallaby, platypus or kangaroo on your walk.

KOROROIT CREEK

Length: 3km - 10km
Difficulty: Easy
A picturesque shared use path for cyclists and pedestrians, following the Kororoit Creek.

MARIBYRNONG RIVER TRAIL

Length: Up to 25km
Difficulty: Mostly Easy
A meandering path that follows the river bank of the Maribyrnong River between Footscray and Brimbank Park.

TAYLORS CREEK TRAIL

Length: ~8.5km
Difficulty: Easy
Journey through the beautiful Taylors Creek Valley and then on past huge River Red Gums and remnants of ancient lava flows between Brimbank Park and Taylors Lakes.

JONES CREEK TRAIL

Length: ~2km
Difficulty: Easy
Follows Jones Creek passing through one of Brimbank's flagship parks, Kevin Flint Memorial Reserve.
